

If you test **POSITIVE** for **COVID-19**
ISOLATE - regardless of vaccination status, previous
infection or lack of symptoms

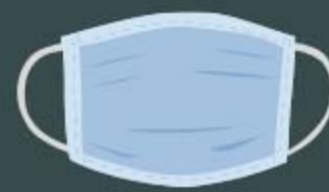


Day 1-5



Stay Home

Day 6-10



Isolation can end after day 5 if symptoms are not present and you have a negative test.

If unable to test or choosing not to test, and symptoms are not present or are resolving, isolation can end after day 10.

Continue to wear a mask around others for a total of 10 days.

If fever is present, isolation should be continued until fever resolves.

If you were EXPOSED to COVID-19 and not Vaccinated or not yet BOOSTED You have to quarantine



Day 1-5



Stay Home

Stay home for at least 5 days after your last contact with a person who has COVID-19.

Day 5



Test on day 5

Day 6-10



Quarantine can end after day 5 if symptoms are not present and test negative on day 5 or later. If unable to test or choosing not to test, and symptoms are not present, quarantine can end after day 10. Continue to wear a mask around others for a total of 10 days.

If you were EXPOSED to COVID-19 and are Vaccinated and BOOSTED You do not have to quarantine

Test on day 5

Day 1-10



Wear a well-fitting mask around others for 10 days.
If testing positive, follow isolation recommendations.
If symptoms develop, test and stay home.
